

**Hardy County Courthouse, 911 Center
Limited Access; Limited Employee Plan
Immediate release: 3/24/2020 Updated 4/2/2020**

The goal of the Hardy County Elected Officials is to take the steps necessary to protect our staff and still serve the public's needs during these uncharted times. In order to accomplish this goal, we continue to work with various local, state and federal agencies to monitor the rapidly changing mandates and recommendations for Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Beginning Monday, March 24, 2020 at 9am, the county offices will remain open with limited staff rotation during normal business hours but entrance to the Courthouse will be limited to appointments and emergencies only. The 911 Center will be closed to public walk thru.

Before entering the facility, individuals will be questioned as to recent travel and exposure to other individuals that may have shown symptoms of the Coronavirus. Individuals may be restricted from entering the facility to safeguard the public and employees.

Regarding voting for the May primary, Hardy County officials encourage individuals to contact the Voters Division with the Office of County Clerk 304-530-0250 to request an absentee ballot or go online at <http://hardycounty.com/hardy-county-clerk> this will assist in limiting exposure for the voting public as well as poll workers.

Regarding payment of Taxes and Ambulance Fee payments, Hardy County officials encourage individuals to contact the Tax Office of the Hardy County Sheriff 304-530-0220 or online at <http://hardycounty.com/sheriff> to request further directions for payments.
